



She was a correspondent for The Oprah Winfrey Show and contributor to ABC News' "Nightline" and National Geographic's' "Explorer." Ling also hosted "Our America" on OWN: the Oprah Winfrey Network.

In addition, she is known for the highly publicized event of her sister Laura's kidnapping in North Korea. She and her sister later penned Somewhere Inside: One Sister's Captivity in North Korea and the Other's Fight to Bring her Home.

She is also the co-author of Mother, Daughter, Sister, Bride: Rituals of Womanhood, and is a co-founder of SecretSocietyofWomen.com, a contributor to iVolunteer.org.

She guides people so that they have courage to be the person they dream of, get liberated from their fears, and go the distance in their relationships!
