



## COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTERS

Community Medical Centers has been giving back to California's San Joaquin Valley for more than 100 years. As the most comprehensive and technologically advanced hospital system in the region, Community operates three acute care hospitals—Community Regional Medical Center, Clovis Community Medical Center and Fresno Heart & Surgical Hospital—along with several long-term care, outpatient and other health care facilities.

Community Medical Centers is a locally owned, not-for-profit, public-benefit organization providing central California with acute care, outpatient centers, clinics, home care, community education, physician groups and a physician residency program in conjunction with the University of California, San Francisco. Based in Fresno, Community is the region's largest health care provider. It operates the most comprehensive burn center in the Valley and the only Level 1 trauma center from Sacramento to Los Angeles, and is home to the region's only high-risk antepartum unit. The level III neonatal intensive care unit provides the highest level of care for infants. Community also serves as the area's essential "safety-net" provider. In fiscal year 2007-2008, Community provided nearly \$137.1 million in unpaid services to the medically underserved and as a benefit to the community. Community is Fresno's largest private employer and is a leader in urban redevelopment with the continuing construction at Community Regional Medical Center in downtown Fresno.
