Central California Women's Conference invites Valley non-profits to apply for share of \$70,000

The Board of Directors of the Central California Women's Conference (CCWC) is seeking non-profits serving women and children to apply for mini-grants totaling \$70,000. The winners will be recognized at CCWC's Community Celebration Grant Reception on Wednesday, April 6.

The criteria for grant submission are posted on www.ccwc-fresno.org. All grant applications must be submitted by January 25. Awards will be made only to Central Valley non-profits serving women and children.

To date CCWC has donated more than \$665,000 to Valley non-profits serving women and children. Funding has benefited recipients by providing an array of services ranging from mammograms to food, shelter, clothing, education and more.

Now in its 29th year, more than 84,000 women have attended the Central California Women's Conference. This year's event will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 20, 2016 at the Fresno Convention & Entertainment Center.
