She was a correspondent for *The Oprah Winfrey Show* and contributor to ABC News' "Nightline" and National Geographic's "Explorer." Ling also hosted "Our America" on OWN: the Oprah Winfrey Network.

In addition, she is known for the highly publicized event of her sister Laura's kidnapping in North Korea. She and her sister later penned *Somewhere Inside: One Sister's Captivity in North Korea and the Other's Fight to Bring her Home*.

She is also the co-author of *Mother, Daughter, Sister, Bride: Rituals of Womanhood*, and is a co-founder of **SecretSocietyofWomen.com**, a contributor to **iVolunteer.org**.

She guides people so that they have courage to be the person they dream of, get liberated from their fears, and go the distance in their relationships!
