The Central California Women's Conference was founded in 1988 by the late Senator Kenneth L. Maddy of Fresno, CA. The non-profit, non-political conference was created to educate, motivate and inspire women of all generations, ethnicities and backgrounds to excel in their personal and professional lives.

Since 1988, the conference has served more than 86,950 women from the Central Valley and surrounding cities such as Sacramento, Los Angeles and San Francisco.

To date CCWC has donated more than \$900,000 to various non-profit agencies serving women and children in the Central Valley.

### **Scholarship Partners**

The Central California Women's Conference also serves through its CCWC/Wells Fargo Preparatory Scholarship Program--now in its 6th year. In 2016, 20 students from Fresno, Sanger, McLane and Central (east campus) high schools participated. They each received a scholarship, attended the conference, and also participated in a financial literacy workshop.

> In addition, CCWC, AT&T and the Central California Educational Opportunity Center (CCEOC) support a re-entry scholarship program. CCEOC's mission is to assist individuals throughout the Valley to re-enroll in college. Through this scholarship program, five female Valley re-entry students were selected by CCEOC based on need, goals and promise.

And, through its partnership with PG&E, last year CCWC awarded its first "She Makes a Difference" award to Andrea Shabaglian for her work with Made For Them, an organization that fights human trafficking through fashion.
