### **Central California Women's Conference invites Valley non-profits to apply for a share of \$100,000**

The Board of Directors of the Central California Women's Conference (CCWC) is seeking local community benefit organizations serving women and children to apply for a share of the \$100,000 in available grant money. The recipients will be recognized at CCWC's Community Celebration Grant Reception on Tuesday, April 23.

All grant requests must be submitted online. The criteria for grant submissions and application can be found at <http://www.ccwc-fresno.org/grantapp/>. All grant applications must be submitted by 5 p.m. on Friday, January 11, 2019. Awards will be made only to Central Valley non-profits serving women and children who have served the community for at least three years.

When this year's grant awards are included, CCWC will have donated more than \$1,100,000 to Valley non-profits serving women and children. Funding has benefited recipients by providing an array of services ranging from mammograms to food, shelter, clothing, education and more.

Now in its 32<sup>nd</sup> year, more than 94,150 women have attended the Central California Women's Conference. This year's event will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 17, 2019 at the Fresno Convention & Entertainment Center.
